AMENDMENTS/ADDENDUM TO DENR MC NO. 2009-03 ENTITLED SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURE IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UPLAND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (UDP)

To ensure the effective and smooth implementation of the Upland Development Program (UDP), the following provisions are hereby amended/added:

Section 4. Organization and pre-development activities

4.1 Organizational arrangement within DENR

Paragraph 4, item 2:

- (2) prepare map and related documents.
- 4.2 Determination of areas and selection of participantimplementors
 - 4.2.2.5 A pro-forma Letter of Intent (LOI) [Annex D-1 to D-4], together with a sketch plan of the area, shall be submitted by the prospective organization/individual to the DENR. Should the prospective organization/individual be selected as beneficiary/partner, the LOI and the sketch plan shall form part of the Letter of Agreement (LOA)
- 4.4 Area development planning and final agreements

Paragraph 2, first sentence.

The final output shall be a work plan together with the physical target specifications, and the final disbursement schedules.

Section 5. Development Cost Standards

- . 5.2 Planting stock production
 - 5.2.1 **Purchase of seedlings** the seedlings to be purchased shall be on its plantable size depending on the kind of species that is in the best condition for outplanting in the field. This should be supported by a Supply Contract to be submitted to DENR as one of the requirements for the 2nd release.

3 rd release	25% of the project cost to be released after completing the activities under 2 nd release	Upon completion of the activities on the 2 nd release.
4 th release	10% of the project cost to be released after completing the first cycle maintenance and protection activities such as strip brushing, ring weeding and replanting to meet the 95% survival rate requirement	After two (2) months from the 3 rd release
